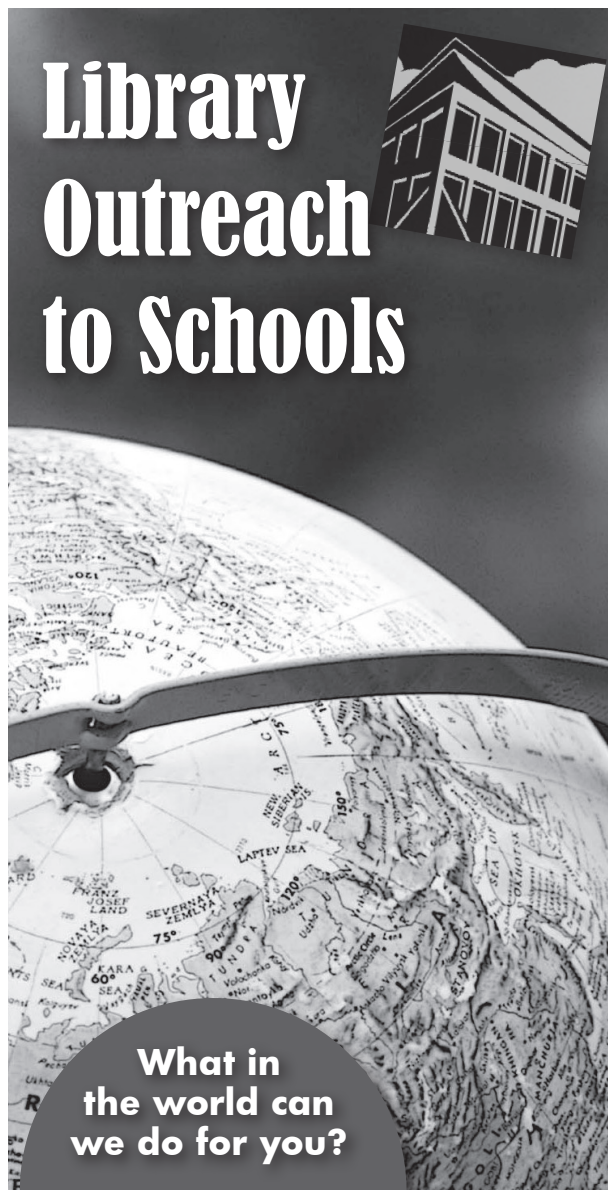

### Grades K - 2

**BOOKTALKS:** These short oral summaries are a great way to introduce kids to books that are new, on a particular theme or by celebrated authors. Given a two-week notice, a booktalk can be created to accompany a subject in your curriculum.

**\*TUMBLEBOOKS:** Where stories come to life! This online library is filled with free animated, talking picture books and games that kids can listen to, read-a-long and play with.

### Grades 3 - 5

### Grades 6 - 8
